Entries will be judged through the People's Choice voting tickets (\$1 each). A display base will be provided for each entry.

People's choice voting will be tallied by the GFWC Woman's League of Mount. Holly.

Awards:

Amateurs will receive ribbons for the top three places in each category. A People's Choice award will be selected by the public on Fire & Ice Day (January 29, 2022) with the purchase of a voting ticket at \$1.00 each. Entry with the most tickets wins.
